I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parents' Code of Conduct.

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports event.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.
3. I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
4. I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Conduct.
5. I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.
6. I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults. I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.
7. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
8. I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.
9. I promise to make a commitment to volunteer and assist my program when asked, making time whenever I can.
10. No ice chest allowed at any games, unless they are for player use; if so they will remain on the sidelines.
11. No selling of team shirts, hats or any other accessories will be tolerated by an individual other than the team area.
12. **No social media bashing will be tolerated on individuals/league team sites, message boards, Facebook or valley youth football site. Any will result in removal of team/league. Int _____ (parent/guardian)**
